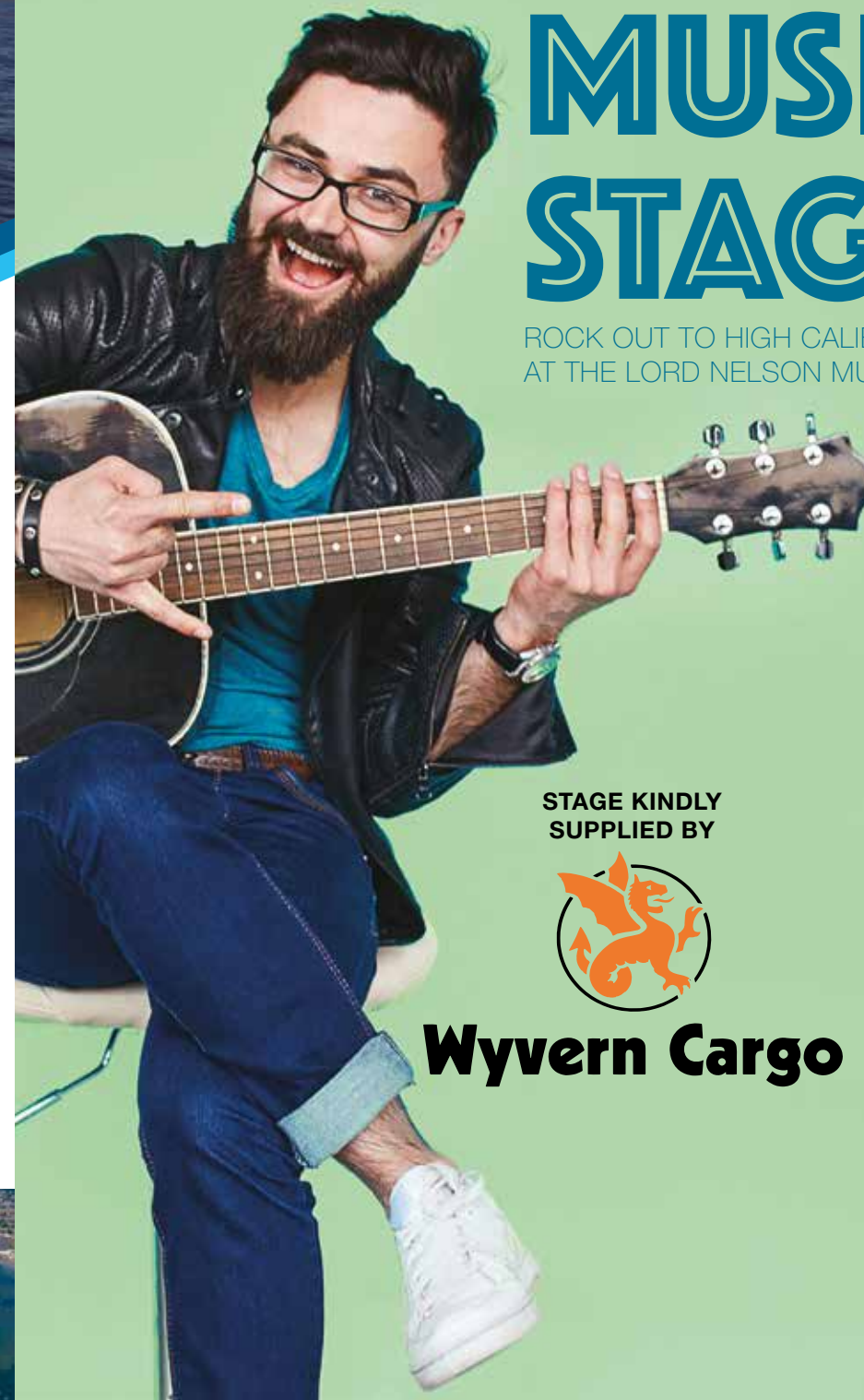

# PIP HARE GOING SOLO



Globe Race, with the aim of becoming the tenth British sailor and the eighth woman ever to cross the finish line. Pip Secured her 60ft race boat called 'Superbigou' in January this year and with the support of Poole Harbour Commissioners and other local business has made Poole Harbour the home for her campaign.

In November 2020 Pip Hare will be on the start line of one of the world's most elite sporting events when she lines up to take part in the Vendee Globe Race.

The Vendee Globe Race is a single handed, non-stop sailing race, around the world sailed in 60ft ocean race boats, capable of speeds in excess of 30mph. The race is held every four years and in the entire history of the race less than 100 skippers have crossed the finish line, among these was Dame Ellen MacArthur who came 2nd in 2001.

Pip Hare has been solo ocean racing for ten years, all the time working towards the ultimate goal of taking part in the Vendee

Over the next two years building up to the campaign Pip must train, race and prepare for the big event. The race itself will take around 90 days to complete – this is 90 days where Pip must be performing, managing the boat, changing sails, navigating, fixing problems, battling the elements all day every day. There is no off switch when you are solo ocean racing. Pip will only be able to sleep for bursts of 20-30 minutes at time and all of the time 'Superbigou' will be charging through the waves and the wind, bouncing, surfing slamming towards the finish line.

Solo ocean racing is an utterly uncompromising sport and encompasses so many more skills than just sailing. The skipper must

be proficient in mechanics, electronics, satellite communications, they must be prepared to climb the mast at sea to make repairs underway, to treat their own medical problems. To sail single handed around the world requires mental, physical and emotional strength.

Pip is keen to share her campaign with as many people as possible to give an honest account of what racing this boat is like and to recount the incredible experiences she will have along the way. As part of this pledge Pip is making the boat available to look over at the Poole boat show and will be there with her team to talk about her experience to date. Come and visit us in the marina, experience the sheer size of the boat, look at Pip's living accommodation, how she will cook and where she will sleep. Imagine what it will be like to sail the boat around the world – alone.

# ECO AMBITION

## Poole Harbour Boat Show has big eco ambitions!

### WHAT ARE WE DOING?....

We're showing our commitment to marine conservation and have big eco ambitions for this year's Poole Harbour Boat Show, in association with Sunseeker.

### WHY ARE WE DOING IT?.....

We've all heard the message, we all know it - single-use plastic is bad, bad, bad! Ever since Blue Planet II aired, we've been increasingly conscious of the vast islands of plastic floating in the ocean. Heart-breaking images have circulated on the internet, sparking a national debate. We wanted to make changes and become more environmentally aware, but we also want to help spread the message and encourage others to be more aware. Even the small changes can make a difference when we work together!

### HOW ARE WE DOING IT?.....

We are eliminating our use of single-use plastics, wherever possible, and we've asked our exhibitors to do the same by providing them with our 'top tips' for being an eco-friendly exhibitor. We also want to encourage visitors to the boat show to bring refillable water bottles and use the refill stations that will be provided over the weekend **(see page 9 for refill locations)**. To continue with the reduction of single use plastic, Poole Quay Boat Haven will be providing refillable coffee cups to all our exhibitors – it's a long weekend for those involved and caffeine helps!

But it's not just the use of single use plastics that we're focusing on. We've changed our cleaning products to a more environmentally friendly brand and hired in extra recycling collection points to ensure that rubbish from the weekend is disposed of correctly.



We were also delighted to have teamed up with 'GoPladdle' for 'The Big Harbour Clean Up' which took place from 18th – 19th May, in advance of the show. GoPladdle was founded by Jake Sculthorp and Rosie Bailey along the south coast of the UK, with a mission to unite communities and clean up our oceans and beaches, focusing not just on cleaning efforts but also prevention.

Jake commented, "In recent years, awareness of plastic pollution has increased, but unfortunately, so has the scale of the problem. Of 13 billion plastic bottles used each year in the UK, only 7.7 billion (59%) are collected for recycling. This begs the question, where is the other 41% going?"

Jake and Rosie will be flying the flag for GoPladdle at the show on stand WR14. They will be displaying some the plastics that we found during the Big Harbour Clean Up in order to create awareness and illustrate the problems we are facing with plastic pollution in our beautiful harbour.

**Anne Baker** - Alternative Solutions to Plastic - change consultant, scientist, ocean advocate

Osprey are an incredibly evocative bird of prey that attract a lot of attention, and learning about their ecology and behaviour in a harbour context is a must see.

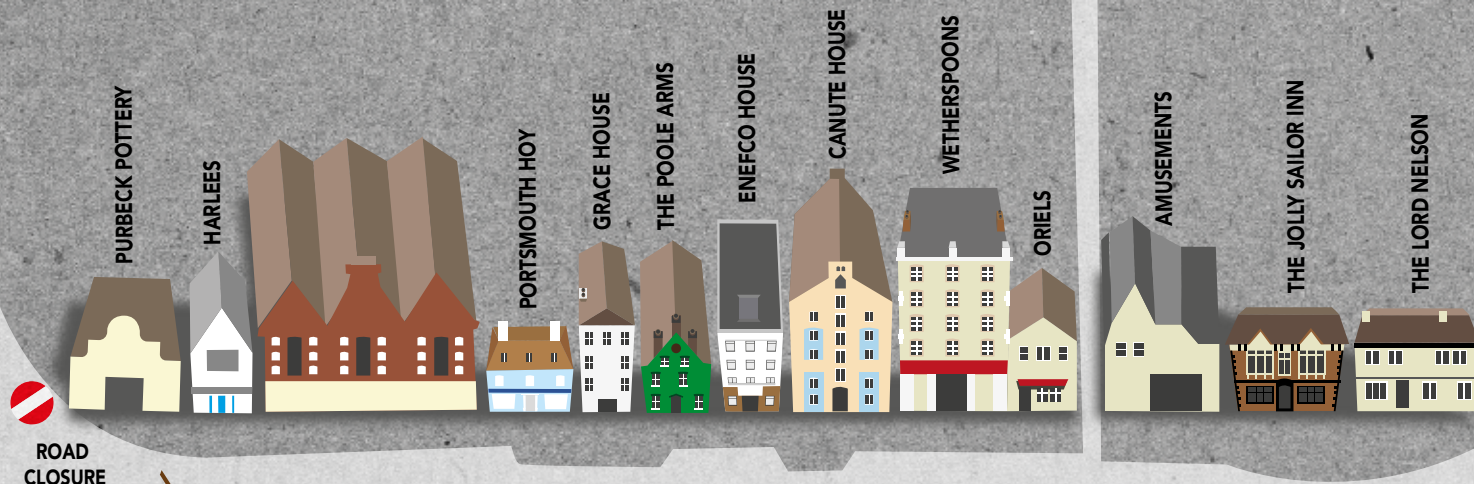

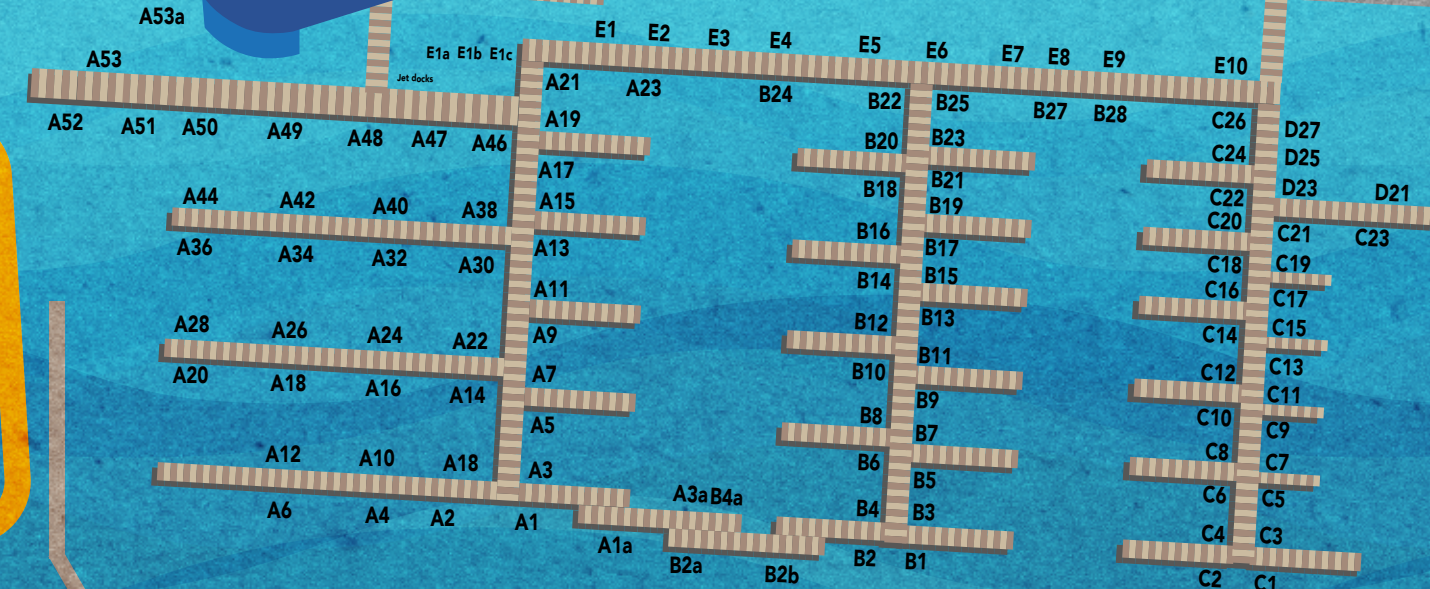

# THE 2019 POOLE HARBOUR BOAT SHOW SUPPORTS THE OCEAN YOUTH TRUST

This year the Boat Show is supporting the Ocean Youth Trust South (OYT South) as its dedicated charity partner.

In the lead up to the show the boat show team have been busy raising enough money to give 15 young people from Dorset the opportunity to participate in a free 5-night voyage, aboard the 32-metre sail training vessel Prolific. The youngsters will sail as active crew members, responsible for sail handling, steering, watch-keeping, helping with navigational and voyage planning, cooking and cleaning and more! # POOLE MUSEUM

Journey into Poole's rich history

Whilst enjoying your stay in Poole, you simply cannot miss a trip to Poole Museum which is housed in four closely connected but very different buildings.

Begin your journey through the atrium building which was once occupied by Poole's first public library, founded in 1830.

You then walk through into Oakley's Mill, a Victorian grain warehouse and flour mill with floors supported by heavy beams and posts.

The medieval Ship Inn used to occupy this site and, from that building, we have a remarkable set of carved timbers – two of which are displayed on the first floor. This building houses the museum displays and the offices of the Borough of Poole Museum Service and Arts Development Unit.

The Local History Centre is situated in the third building that used to be the Town Cellars. A medieval warehouse, originally built around 1300, it has impressive stone walls and a magnificent timber roof.

Across Salisbury Street is the fourth building, Scaplen's Court, Poole's most complete medieval domestic building. This is now principally dedicated to the Museum education service. The herb and physic garden is open throughout the summer and Scaplen's Court can be visited during August.

Together these buildings form Poole Museum, which tells the story of the area that is now the Borough of Poole. It is a fascinating story that will take you through thousands of years, across oceans and into the lives of many Poole people.
